**Subject: Grant of conditional permission to BVV Sangha's BVVS Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, BVVS Old Campus, Belgavi-Raichur Road Bagalkot, Karnataka-587101 with 30 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic session 2020-21-reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the Part-1 of the proforma of inspection of college submitted by the **BVV Sangha's BVVS Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital** and recommended as under:-

*"Recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 60 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course.*

*The Committee also recommended to apprise the Ministry that the website of college is not updated and 04 Lecturers are getting very less salary (Rs. 5000/month) and college has not complied with the provisions of Employee's Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provident Act 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations."*

2. An opportunity of Hearing through video conferencing was given to the college on 04.11.2020 to represent their case before the designated hearing Committee. The college representative made their submission to the Hearing Committee.

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, observation of hearing committee, Policy of Ministry dated 03.02.2021 and, consent given by the college, **conditional permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to BVV Sangha's BVVS Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, BVVS Old Campus, Belgavi-Raichur Road Bagalkot, Karnataka-587101 for continuing admissions in BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of 30 seats in UG (BHMS) course.**

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4. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS and MD course shall be treated as All India quota. The counselling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government vide letter F. No. L. 11011/02/2020-E- (1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

6. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

7. Further, the College shall comply with the procedure to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2021-22.

8. Further, it is informed that the compliance of the all the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder by the college up to 31.12.2020, will be taken in to consideration for grant / denial of permission for the next academic year i.e. 2021-22.
